Life Skills Development

806 middle and high school students completed Botvin LifeSkills curriculum
80% increased their resilience skills to refuse alcohol & other drugs
75% increased their perception of harm from alcohol & other drugs





Family Connection

<u>18</u> youth & their families completed the Strengthening Families Program 10-14 75% increased use of healthy coping and stress management skills

One-on-One Mentoring

144 youth were matched with adult mentors 100% of mentees became aware of risks of using alcohol, tobacco & other drugs 98% of mentees did not use alcohol or other drugs in the past 3 months 99% of mentees were not involved in the juvenile justice system





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
