



RISE Drug Free MKE (formerly known as the Milwaukee County Substance Abuse Prevention coalition) convenes 40+ diverse partners across Milwaukee County to build skills and provide substance use prevention and harm reduction information and materials to community members. Community Advocates Public Policy Institute has administered this coalition since 2013.

RISE Drug Free MKE's work includes a special emphasis on the health and well-being of youth in the 53206 neighborhoods of Amani and Lindsey Heights through its Drug Free Communities Project.

Our 2022 Impact

940 people participated in substance-free activities

30,072 prevention materials distributed

71 prevention activities sponsored

289 prevention professionals completed 1 training

173 people attended mental health awareness & substance use prevention trainings

8,682 residents attended outreach events and community presentations

18,889 people reached on social media

882 students participated in life skills workshops

76% of participating youth surveyed said they increased their knowledge, attitudes & skills needed to make good choices or prevent harmful behavior
