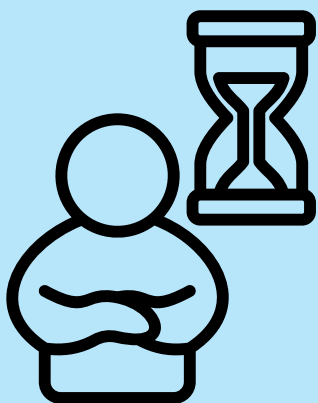

Pick 'n Save closed another store in Milwaukee this summer, raising food access concerns among residents.

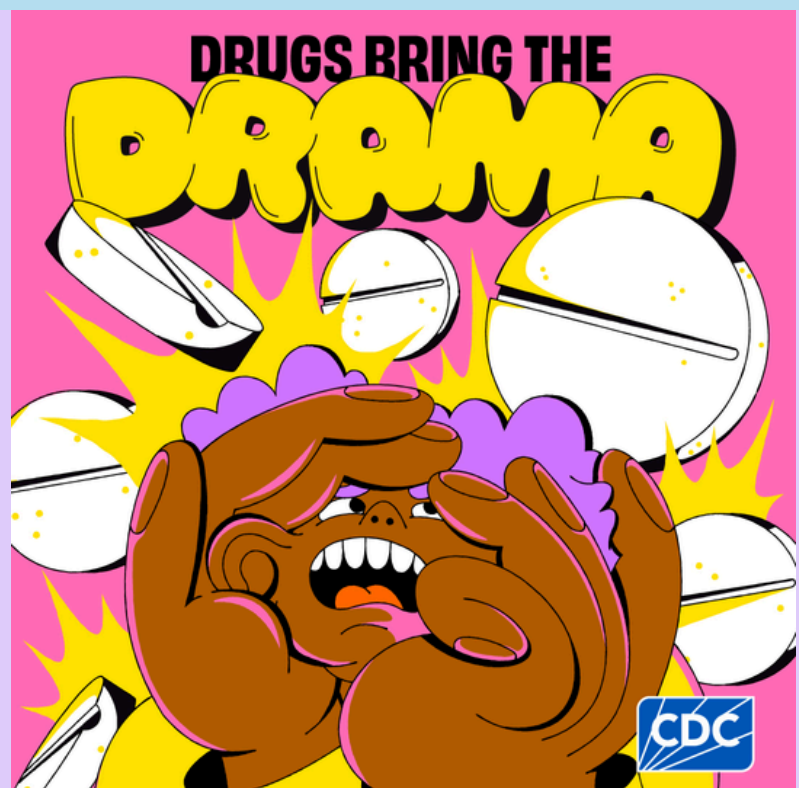

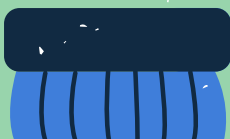
